COMPLEX REFLECTIONS:

SIMILE AND METAPHOR

The main difference between **simile** and metaphor is that:

Simile uses the words "like" or "as" to draw a comparison directly to an image.

Example of a **Simile**: She is as innocent **as** an angel. Or, Time is precious and limited **like** money.

Metaphor simply states the comparison to an image **without** using "like" or "as". It's used to compare one thing to another that appears different but may have one similar quality.

Example of a **Metaphor**: She is an angel. Or, Time is Money.
