- In 2022, funding from the Opioid to Action Grant allowed our Cyzap system to track the housing situation of our clients.
- When creating a client profile or completing an assessment in Cyzap, ensure that the homeless situation is marked.
- The Department of Health provided the following definitions of Housing Situation.

Emergency Shelters Any facility whose primary purpose is to provide temporary shelter for the homeless in general or for specific populations of the homeless

Shelters Supervised publicly or privately operated shelter designated to provide temporary living arrangement (Including congregate shelter, transitional housing, and hotels and motels paid for by charitable organizations or by federal, state, or local government programs for low income individuals

Transitional Housing Housing where all program participants have signed a lease or occupancy agreement, the purpose of which is to facilitate the movement of homeless individuals and families to the permanent housing within 24 months or longer as HUD deems necessary

Unsheltered Individuals whose primary night time residence is a public or private place not designated for or ordinarily used as a regular sleeping accommodation for human beings

Other Any housing situation that doesn't fit any of the above. This may include owning or renting, living with family or roommates, and clean & sober housing

Data collected from August 2022 to October 2023 shows the following data on the different types of Housing Situation

Shelters 78

Transitional Housing 77

Unsheltered 416
